Ten Manchester Street

Opening on Monday (October 12), TEN Manchester Street in London's trendy Marylebone is a boutique (45 rooms) hotel with stays from £169 for a superior room. Cigar lovers should note it has an outdoor smoking Cigar lounge terrace, complete with bespoke designed humidor by Hunters & Frankau, the UK's sole supplier of Cuban cigars.

Bermondsey Square Hotel (b²)

Also boutique (60 rooms) this new hotel close to London Bridge Station is aiming for business travellers and hosting meetings. There are three conference rooms with natural daylight, banqueting for up to 80 people and reception capacity for 150, and a private screening facility for up to 50 people at the Shortwave Cinema on the Square (where the antique market takes place every Friday). Other draws: a private members bar on the first floor, a terrace garden for alfresco dining for up to 120 people and Alfie's, the 90-seat restaurant sourcing an all-English menu from nearby Borough Market. Opening rates of £99 per room.
